Cortix offers 6 modules:

- **News** (present information in the form of articles)
- **Catalogue** (present goods or services with online payment)
- **Photo gallery** (online photo, illustration or plan management)
- **Media library** (upload videos or music)
- **Forum** (offer a message board for Internet users on given themes)
- **File sharing** (upload files by allowing access to Internet users via an authentication interface)
